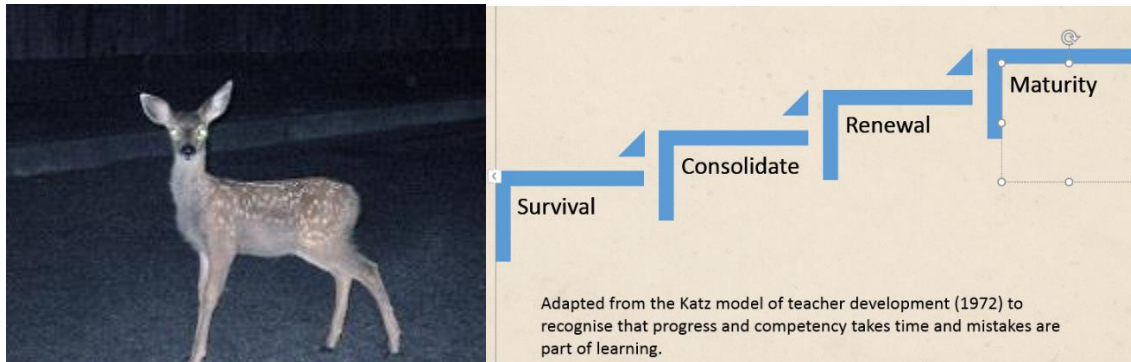


Exploring the issues

- Freeze in using the e-portfolio – these students will want to succeed but really don't know what this looks like, they are likely to say everything is fine and then not turn in a formative assessment. This may also be associated with panic e-mails and requests for tutorial support. There is very little evidence of work in the portfolio (although lots of work in note books etc)



- Adapted from the Katz model (1972) of teacher development to recognise that progress and competency takes time and mistakes are part of learning.
- Survival – it's OK to be a beginner: need support, encouragement and guidance
- Consolidate – joint exploration, share opportunities to recognise progress with others
- Renewal – Try something new be more experimental, look for challenges
- Maturity – become an autonomous and successful learner and able to support others, work is more insightful
